but more frequently percurrent, calyciform or cylindrical. *Conidia* mostly solitary, in a few species catenate, dry, acrogenous, simple, ellipsoidal, pyriform, obovoid or clavate, pale or dark brown, cells often unequally coloured, 1–5-septate, frequently with very dark brown or black bands at the septa, smooth




Fig. 103. Endophragmia species (1): A, elliptica; B, atra; C, australiensis; D, taxi; E, catenulata; F, stemphylioides; G, prolifera (× 650 except where indicated by the scale).
