

Gregarious on naked sandy soil (probably a burnt place).


Apothecium diam up to 4 mm.

Spores ellipsoid, non amyloid, 25 x 10 µm

Paraphyses filiform, slightly clavate, somewhat bended toward apex, with yellow oil drops that turn black in Melzer's reagent.

Asci inoperculate, non amyloid.

At margin with few thick walled hairs, wall thickness up to 2 µm, length up to 85 µm.
